Yet many Autistic employees face social barriers in the workplace, from unclear expectations to exclusion from team dynamics. Without intentional strategies to build belonging, workplaces miss out on the strengths of neurodiverse talent. This course addresses the critical need for organizations to foster inclusive social environments where all employees thrive.

Becoming an Autism-Informed Organization: Embracing Social Inclusion and Belonging explores how to create workplace cultures that value connection, equity, and meaningful inclusion. Participants will learn how social norms, team dynamics, and emotional needs impact Autistic individuals—and how to support inclusion through structured collaboration, clear expectations, and inclusive practices. Through real-world case studies and actionable strategies, this course offers a roadmap for building connected, resilient teams.

- **Recognize Social Barriers** Identify common social barriers faced by Autistic individuals.
- Clarify Workplace Norms Create transparency around workplace expectations and social dynamics.
- **Promote Structured Collaboration** Learn strategies to support inclusive teamwork and peer connections.
- Supporting Emotional Regulation Address isolation and support emotional regulation through inclusive practices.
- Sustain a Sense of Belonging Foster lasting inclusion with feedback loops, recognition, and leadership opportunities.
